



## Active Attack Integrated Response (AAIR) Train-the-Trainer

*For Police, Fire, EMS, and Public Safety Communications Personnel*

NERAC is sponsoring one (1) offering of the five-day Active Attack Integrated Response (AAIR) Train-the-Trainer course for first responders from the NERAC region. The AAIR course, created and developed by the ALERRT Center at Texas State University, improves the integration of Police, Fire, and EMS personnel during active shooter events. Students learn medical skills based on TECC guidelines, how to establish initial/unified command, and the importance of rendering aid to victims via rescue task forces.

All first responders from the NERAC region are eligible to attend this course, however **participants will be expected to lead periodic regional active shooter trainings after their certification is confirmed.**

**Backfill/overtime reimbursement will be offered at up to \$35/hour.**
